RUPA- Rural Uplift Programs and Awareness

Community development project was started in 2021 in 3 villages of Jumbulingapuram panchayat with a total population of 1200 people where 90% of them live under the poverty line. We are currently two years into the program. This project aims to bring 570 families out of poverty by the end of March 2024.

We raised the livelihood of people living below poverty line in the village by 289 families in 2021-2022 and 350 families in 2022-23.

Empowerment- 56 people and their families benefited from the scheme this year. The skill levels and the need were assessed, and we enabled them to get chickens, goats, set up petti shops, idli shops and tailoring business. Among them 8 are people with disability. They were also taught financial literacy, educating them about the importance of saving and reinvesting in their business. Now they are earning a good income through their own labor and living a better life.



Vocational training-

Two tailoring centers have been established at S. Pudur and Jambulingapuram.



In our centers we had 55 women learn tailoring skills in our centres this year.

We provided sewing machines to 18 of them. Through this, everyone has raised their livelihood by sewing clothes in their homes and nearby garment factories.

Women from the tailoring centre were given exposure visits to nearby garment factory. They were taken on a tour to a garment factory in Puliuth. There were many competitions. They enjoyed this worthwhile exposure visit. Seven unemployed youths were taught driving training. All those who have taken driving lessons from us are self-employed. This is start to their better future.



“DAIA helped me to buy a power sewing machine. I completed sewing training in sewing training conducted by DAIA. Now I sew ready-made garments at home and supply them to export companies. Apart from that, by teaching her husband to sew, both of them sew together and increase their income. Thank you to the sponsors who made this possible” - Mrs. Gangai Veila.

Adult Literacy

45 people in 3 villages benefited from adult literacy classes. Through these classes the illiterates were taught basic literacy skills, general knowledge and basic numeracy skills.

Financial Literacy

Beneficiaries of the economic development program were given classes on how to further develop their businesses and how to save the incoming investment.

Adolescent Awareness



A youth gathering was held at Jumbulingapuram. During the meeting Mrs.Prema emphasised importance of the work without wasting time, and addressed that if we work smartly, we can progress in life.

Training program

Nutrition powder preparation training, Surf training, Agriculture training and moringa soup preparation training was given to the communities. This training had enabled them to include a variety of nutrition in them diet especially young mothers and children.

Agriculture Project

On behalf of DAIA the farmers were given a demonstration of how to handle a sprayer with a solar lamp. There by 2 persons were provided with solar powered sprayer.



Hygiene Awareness program

DAIA in collaboration with Jumbulingapuram Village Rural Development Department conducted a program on rural women hygiene. Ms. Aswathi [PRDA] attended and taught them about women's health and sanitary practices of using cotton pads during menstruation. Ovarian cancer and whitening in women were also explained.



Environmental Sanitation program

Awareness was conducted on the need for everyone to use toilets, to avoid plastic waste and to improve hygiene. In this, a rally was conducted by the village common people, leaders, local school students and students of Annammal College along with DAIA staff.

SCAD meeting

An awareness program was conducted by Mrs. Padma, an employee in association with SCAD charity to save women in village development program and involve women groups in government financial management program.

Eye Camp – Dr.Agrawal's Hospital

DAIA and Dr.Agarwal's Eye Hospital organized a free ophthalmology camp for the people of 4 villages, namely, Jambulingapuram, Pudupappacherry, S.Pudur and Veerapandiyapuram 158 people participated and benefited. The people were treated for cataracts, nearsightedness, farsightedness and other eye problems.



Special report



Panchayat Drinking Water

A field inspection on behalf of our DAIA in S.Pudur village revealed that there was not enough water for the general population there. This was taken up with Annammal College for Women through an awareness program, on how the people are suffering due to water scarcity. The people unanimously put this demand before the panchayat chief. The chairman said he would rectify the situation within this year. According to that the drinking water was connected on 26-05-2022 at a cost of about 7 lakhs. The village people were excited.

On a broad scale, the villages where the work has been done has started to flourish, we see many hopeful small businessmen/women, more skilled people ready for a job. We can see the community coming together to work and care for their own. We are glad to see them take the steps to a brighter future.

Youth of Jumbulingapuram planted pungai saplings in the park area under “Namakku naame scheme” along with DAIA.

A Gram Sabha meeting was held in Jambulingapuram village in which three villagers participated. In this meeting, agricultural credit, women group development, how much government subsidy can be availed through bank were discussed.

A leadership meeting was held to connect the village leaders in the village development plan.



Tuition centres



We conduct tuition centres at 10 centres Jothibass nagar, Vellapatti, Kandasamy puram, Thambikai meendan, Rama natchiyarpuram, Rajapandi nagar, Siluvaipatti, Madathur, Vallinayagipuram, Millerpuram regularly. The children are given a nutritious snack, and helped with their homework from Monday to Saturday.

Also, the teachers engaged them in sports, conducting science experiments using chemical materials, making craft from recyclable materials, conducting debate, public speaking, etc.

Online Classes DAIA, in collaboration with TATA Proengage conducts online English classes on Saturdays at 4 centers by TATA Proengage volunteers. The TATA Group gives us their time and knowledge. Ramesh and Karthik from Tata company visited the tuition center at Vellapatti, Jothibassnagar and Alagumuthunagar in person. Children were given stationery items and work book.

Positive Parenting is a program that involves parents in the child's education. They are also given awareness about Child Protection Act, importance of education, health, hygiene and life skills.

TATA ProEngage program

Volunteers from Tata group employees and their families spend their time and teach are kids basic English, mathematics and other skills through online learning. This year we had Mrs.Varalakshmi, Mrs.Margeret Williams, Mrs. Priyadharashini, Mrs.Anu Parvathi, Mrs. Uma Balasubramnian and Mrs. Nirmala Jayanthi who supported us in this program. A great big thank you to them for making that selfless effort.



Education tour



At our tuition center all the children were taken to the planetarium to develop their general knowledge. There they enjoyed learning about space events and scientists. They were taken to Panjalakurichi Fort where Veerapandiya Kattabomman lived to learn about historical leaders. Also, competitions were held and prizes were awarded to the winners.

International Needs Australia - Visit

International Needs Australia (INA) Chief Executive Officer, Mr. David Ensor, Mr. Sean Carol Daff (INA, International Program Officer) and Ms. Hilda John (DAIA, Executive Director) visited all our projects. They inquired about the economic progress of the beneficiaries of the empowerment program and the current standard of living of the



apprentices in the villages of S. Puthur, Pudupacherry and Jambulingapuram. They visited some tuition centers and enjoyed seeing the children's handicrafts and art performances. This time of fellowship was a great time of joy for visitors and beneficiaries alike.

Embracing Elders

We have supported 44 elders through this program this year. They come together every month for a camp at Zion church, Tuticorin. They are given groceries every month, nutrition powder and medicines. The camp finishes with a good meal and they are transported back to their respective places. It is also a time they come together, share their stories, encourage each other and have a social interaction.

All of our elders are abandoned by their families and they live of the minimum wages they could source out. We advocate for them when

situation arises, provide clothing, bedding, give medical assistance when they need and visit them regularly to check on them.



Apart from the regular camps, a Christmas program was conducted. It was a great celebration of the season and the reason of the season did bring joy and solace to the crowd. They were given new Sarees, shirts, towels, and a banquet to celebrate! We look forward to add more elderly people in our program if we get the chance to.

We thank the elders of the community and the volunteers who help run this program. We are grateful to Zion church who give us the venue.



Medical Camps for HIV/AIDS patients

This year, 115 patients attended the medical camps at Tuticorin and Kovilpatti every month. They are given a health check up by our visiting doctor Dr. Mummoorthy, they are given medicines, iron tonics, nutrition powder and a good meal. Their weight was monitored and their health evaluated. The camps are a great way to social interaction and they get encouraged as they listen to others' struggles, accomplishments and support each other.



The venue is Zion campus at Tuticorin and St. Paul's campus at Kovilpatti. We are thankful for their consistent support. The most impoverished people were given grocery support every month.

Apart from the regular monthly camp, they also celebrated Annual day celebration. The season of Christmas does bring joy to their lives. The women were given sarees, the men were given shirts and children were given a stainless-steel plate and the day finished with a great banquet.

The nutrition powder that we supply all our patients are prepared at DAIA office. Quality ingredients are selected, roasted and powdered and supplied fresh every month. All of our patients say this keeps them going every morning. It had been a great supplement to boost their immunity. Preparation of the nutrition powder is supported by Shalom Charity Mission, Tuticorin. We are thankful to their support.



Annual programs

Through the year Christmas program, children's day program and annual day program day were conducted.

In these programs children showcased their skills and talent in arts, music and dance. In the annual day celebration, the high achieving kids were awarded and also the teachers were honoured. This has been a great achievement in the tuition centres this year in giving a quality education support and social support.



The rural areas had one main Christmas program where all the villagers, roughly 250 people assembled and enjoyed the story of Christmas enacted by children. Many local leaders also attended the program. The tuition centres, elders and HIV patients had their Christmas programs, with around 750 people in attendance. They were given new clothes, gifts for children and a banquet. Many supporters had given in kind to this celebration and we thank them for their contribution. 'Worlds AIDS day' was also celebrated along with the Christmas programs.



Women's day celebration

International Women's Day was celebrated in the village on March 8. 4 village women of Jambulingapuram panchayat also participated in this. Government officials participated in this and said that women have progressed in all fields than in the past and the government has introduced many schemes for the advancement of women. After



the DAIA work, it can be seen that progress has been made in all aspects. Sports competitions were held. Certificates were awarded to 10 women who completed sewing at the ceremony.

Impact 23

In April DAIA impact-2023 meeting was conducted for our well-wishers with video presentation. Hilda John told the gathering that how many beneficiaries were helped through DAIA and it was possible because of everyone's cooperation. And an impact-2023 meeting for well-wishers living in Tuticorin was held at DAIA office.
