




Dear friends,

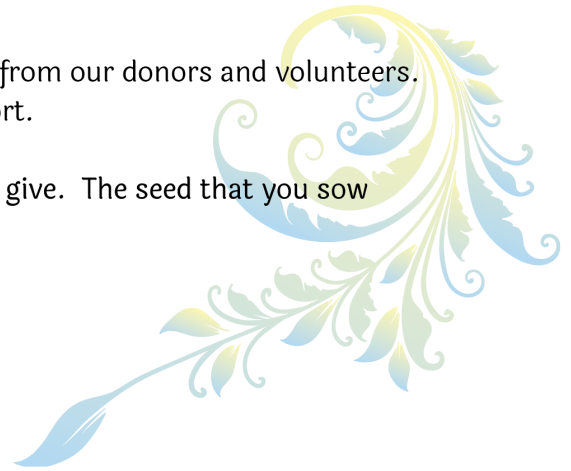
